Since the neighborhood had flyers delivered to every household, the VHCC email list has had a 60% increase (242 subscribers total). Nobody has requested help but Next Door has a "Help Map" set up and apparently requests are being made and filled on Buy Nothing Facebook groups locally.

The Block Watch Captains meeting on April 14th on Zoom had 10 participants.

The Public Health Clinic on Meridian needs cloth masks, if you have any to donate.

"Friday Night Lights" where the city runs fire trucks through various neighborhoods will be hitting Victory Heights on April 24th. They may not be on every street but they will surely pass by the park at some point. The weather should be decent, go out and cheer as they drive by.

May 6-12 is National Nurses Week, and May 10-16 is National Hospital Week.

On March 11th, the homeless encampment under the 15th Avenue NE bridge was cleared out with a massive response by the Navigation Team, Seattle police, and garbage trucks. Due to the corona virus, it might have been the last one done in the city for a while.

The city has been closing various streets down on weekends to make them "Greenways" for pedestrians and bicyclists. They haven't done any in our area...yet.

It's still several months until our annual potluck in late July, we will wait until summer to make a decision about its feasibility this year.
